37th Senior & 28th Junior European Taekwon-Do Championships 2023

1. DATES, VENUE AND ACCOMMODATION

The 37th Senior and 28th Junior European Taekwon-Do Championships will be held on 25th – 30th of April 2023 in BT ARENA, Cluj-Napoca, Romania.

Delegations must arrive in Cluj-Napoca before or on Monday, April 24th, 2023 and must proceed directly to the meeting point BT Arena for registration and payment.



The *BT ARENA* is a multi-purpose indoor arena that is located in Cluj-Napoca, Romania, with 10,000 seats. The arena was previously called the Polyvalent Hall but was renamed on 17th October 2017 when the facility entered into a new arena-naming rights agreement with "Banca Transilvania".

In 2016 Taekwon-do ITF European Cup, was organized in this venue.

NOTE: There will be an extra hall available for athletes to warm-up.







1.4. HOW TO REACH CLUJ-NAPOCA

A. **Cluj-Napoca AIRPORT** is located only 5 kilometers from BT Arena Sporthall. Teams arriving by airplane to Cluj — Napoca Airport can find more information on the web site: https://www.airportcluj.ro/

B. Sibiu AIRPORT

Cluj-Napoca is located only 170 km from Sibiu airport. Teams arriving by plane to Sibiu Airport can find more information on the web-site: https://www.sibiuairport.ro/
Driving time: 2 hours, mostly highway.

For everyone arriving by plane, we can arrange transportation from Sibiu Airport to Cluj-Napoca (Hotel / Venue) and return.

1.5. ACCOMMODATION

- The participants will be accommodated in 3-, 4- and 5-stars hotels with wide offers.

1.6. BOOKINGS AND PAYMENT DEADLINES

1.6.1.ACCOMODATION & CHECK-IN

Check-in to the hotel will be done by one (1) representative of the team. The organization offers a full range of hotels of different quality, 3 stars, 4 stars, up to VIP 5 stars, all hotels are in the proximity of the venue.

Packages for 3- and 4-stars hotels include half board (breakfast and dinner), for 5 stars only breakfast. The hotel service starts on the day of arrival with dinner and ends on the day of departure with breakfast.





VERY IMPORTANT! The minimum number of booking days for each registered participant is 6 days / 5 nights.

All prices are valid until February 26, 2023, after this date the organizer does not guarantee the same prices. The price of accommodation includes half board (for 3 and 4 stars and breakfast for 5 stars) for all participants, free transport of the team to the sports venue and return to the hotel after the competition, if the distance from the hotel to the hall is more than 2 km.

To make a successful booking for a hotel please follow these steps:

- 1. Fill-in "APPENDIX 2" and send it back to the Organizing Committee's e-mail cipi_banea@yahoo.com before or on 26th of February 2023. After this the Organizing Committee will contact the responsible person in each country to confirm the preliminary booking. The 'Accommodation form' must reach the organizing committee at the latest on 26th of February 2023.
- 2. 50% prepayment of total accommodation cost must be made by 26th of February 2023.
- 3. The rest of the amount including small corrections must be sent by 1st of April 2023.
- 4. A small correction in the numbers of attendees can be considered if the difference in numbers is 10% at most. In case it is higher than 10%, then the Organizing Committee cannot guarantee accommodation at the same hotels and / or prices.

Please note that the number of 3 stars hotel accommodation is limited and only the early booking can guarantee you accommodation of the preferred type.

4. REQUIREMENTS

7:00-12:00

4.1.UMPIRES

- The Organizing Committee will cover full board accommodation (no drinks included) for 6 days / 5 nights from Tuesday, 25th to Sunday, 30th of April 2023 for maximum of 50 umpires. Additional 7 umpire computer operators. However, the organizer cannot guarantee the same hotel for the computer operators as for the umpires.
 - Each selected umpire must be additional registered online in Sportdata through the ITF-database.
- Umpires arriving on Monday, 24th of April, will also have an extra day / night of full board accommodation, under the condition to announce their early arrival to the Organizing Committee no later than 1st of March 2023.
- Umpires will be accommodated in twin / double (2 persons) rooms.





- Where an Umpire is sharing accommodation, the guest will need to pay the accommodation rate of € 85,00 per day.
- Single rooms are not available therefore Umpires wishing to stay alone shall be paying an extra fee of € 50,00 per day.
- Umpires not selected but wishing to participate and approved by the AETF Tournament & Umpire Committee, must cover their hotel accommodation according to above mentioned arrangements and will not receive any expense reimbursement by AETF.
- Umpires must attend the Umpire meeting on Tuesday, April 25th, from 16:00-18:30 hours at BT Arena.
- Umpires not present at the mentioned umpire meeting will be removed from the umpire list shall pay their own accommodation expenses.
- Umpires will wear the dress requirements as laid down in the ITF Umpire rules.

Umpires wishing to be selected for the European Championships 2023, must complete the 2023 UMPIRE APPLICATION FORM The 2023 UMPIRE APPLICATION FORM must be approved by the national association and sent to umpire@itf-taekwon-do.eu by 8th of January 2023 at the latest.

4.2. COACHES

- At least 1 coach from participating country must attend the official meeting on Tuesday April 25th, from 15:00 hours at BT Arena.
- Must wear either a training suit or a T-shirt and pants and running shoes while coaching.
 Only one (1) coach of a country is allowed entering the coaching zone at the same time.
 Only a coach can present an official protest.

4.3. COMPETITORS

4.3.1. COMPETITION INFORMATION

Individual entry fee: 150.00 € per competitor (including for competitors competing only in Team disciplines);

Team entry fee: 75.00 € per each team.

Entry fees does not include Competition ID-Card, which is mandatory for the Tournament as an official document for identifying competitors, coaches, umpires, officials and staff. The accommodation booked through the organizer and paid in full will include the Competition ID-Card. If accommodation has not been booked with the organizer, the Competition ID-Card must be purchased from the organizer for 100.00 EURO and is valid for:

- Free entrance to the sports hall,
- Transport from the hotels to the sports hall (if the hotel is more than 2 km away from the hall)
- Entry to the swimming-pool, sauna and fitness in hotels (3* hotel)
- Medical assistance during the competition (for competitors).

The competitor's entry fee can be paid in CASH and in EUROS at the registration of competitors or can be transferred electronically and must be cleared by 2nd of April 2023 to the AETF Bank Account.

4.3.2. INSURANCE

- All competitors must wear official dobok and protection gear currently approved by the ITF.
- All competitors must wear full set of blue or red protection gear according to the draw.
- Awarding dress code no competitors will be admitted to awarding ceremony wearing shorts, casual pants, flip flops or bare footed.

4.3.4. DIVISIONS

- The championships will be for Junior and Senior competitors.
- Juniors must be 14 years old on the first day of the competition.
- Competitors born in the year 2005 must participate as Juniors.
- Competitors born in 2004 or before are Seniors.

5. FLAG AND NATIONAL ANTHEM

Each participating country must bring a flag (size 90 X 130 cm) for the Opening Ceremony.

ABOUT ROMANIA

Romania (*România*) [1] is situated on the western shores of the Black Sea. It enjoys great natural beauty and diversity and a rich cultural heritage. Romania enchants visitors with its scenic mountain landscapes and unspoiled countryside areas, and also with its historic cities and its busy capital.

Over the last decade Romania had undergone a significant development and it is one of the recent members of the European Union. Tourists from western countries might still, even today, enjoy some surprising experiences in Romania. This is a large country which can sometimes be shocking with contrasts: some cities are truly Western Europe like; some villages can seem to have been brought back from the past.

Things for which Romania is famous include: the Carpathian Mountains, sculptor Constantin Brancusi, wine, salt mines, George Enescu, medieval fortresses, Eugene Ionesco, "Dacia" cars, Dracula, stuffed cabbage leaves, Nadia Comaneci, primeval dense forests, the Black Sea, Gheorghe Hagi, sunflower fields, wolves and bears, painted monasteries, the Danube Delta, etc.

With a Black Sea coast to the south-east, it is bordered by Bulgaria to the south, Serbia to the southwest, Hungary to the northwest, Moldova to the northeast and Ukraine in both the north and the east. While its southern regions are usually seen as part of South-east European Balkans, Transylvania, its central and largest region, has a more western European look.







ABOUT CLUJ-NAPOCA

Cluj-Napoca, the largest city in the region of Transylvania, traces its origins back to a Dacian settlement (called *Napuca*) in the 2-nd century A.D. After the Roman take-over of Dacia, Napuca became a Roman fort "*Napoca*" and in 124 A.D., received the rank of "municipium". The city quickly advanced socially and economically and during Marcus Aurelius' reign Napoca received the title "colonia", the highest possible urban status in the Roman Empire.

The name Cluj comes from *Castrum Clus*, first used in the 12-th century as the name of the citadel surrounding the city. *Clus* means "closed" in Latin and refers to the hills that surround the city.

German merchants, who arrived here in the 12th century, rebuilt the medieval earthen walls of Clus in stone after the Tatar invasion of 1241. Known as Klausenburg to the Germans* and Kolozsvár to the Hungarians, Cluj became Cluj-Napoca in the 1970s, when the old Roman name of the city was added to emphasize its Dacian-Roman origin.

With one of the most vibrant economies in the country and a population of around 500'000, Cluj is today a vibrant cultural and education centre. There are six state and many more private universities located in Cluj-Napoca - the city with the highest ratio of students to total number of residents in Romania.

The main square, resplendent with 18th and 19th century buildings and home to many shops and restaurants, is dominated by the 15th century St. Michael's Church, one of the finest examples of gothic architecture in Romania. The square also claims the 18-th century baroque Banffy Palace, housing the weaponry and Romanian art collections of the Art Museum. Visitors who want to learn more about the region should pay a visit to the open-air section of the Ethnographic Museum of Transylvania, a true display of folk architecture. For entertainment, spend an enjoyable evening at the Opera or attend a classical music concert offered by the Cluj Philharmonic.

Cluj-Napoca is one of the seven walled citadels (Siebenbürgen*). Built, in the Middle-Ages, and populated until late 1960s by Transylvanian Saxons (people of German ethnicity who have settled in Transylvania from the mid-12th century until mid-19th century).














